JESUS CHRIST, the son of God, pre-existed with God the Father, for our sake was born of a virgin, lived as a man among men, died on the cross as a complete atonement for our sins, rose again the third day and ascended into heaven. By His perfect life, man may be saved from eternal death. John 3:16, 17

THE SEVENTH DAY is the Sabbath. Adventists believe both Old and New Testaments point to the sacredness of the seventh-day, a memorial to God's creative power, a sign of His authority. Adventists observe the Sabbath from sundown Friday to sundown on Saturday, the seventh in the cycle of creation days. Genesis 2:1-3; Exodus 29:8-11

BAPTISM BY IMMERSION is a biblical figure of the burial of “the old man of sin” and the resurrection of the new man reborn in Christ. Baptism is the rite reserved for those of sufficient maturity to understand its meaning. Matthew 3:3-17
