Adventists observe the Sabbath from sundown Friday to sundown on Saturday, the seventh in the cycle of creation days. Genesis 2:1-3; Exodus 29:8-11

**BAPTISM BY IMMERSION** is a biblical figure of the burial of "the old man of sin" and the resurrection of the new man reborn in Christ. Baptism is the rite reserved for those of sufficient maturity to understand its meaning. Matthew 3:3-17
